Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information. When you visit our websites, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

How do we use cookies?

We use cookies to give you the best possible experience on our website.

Cookies are small text files that are sent to and stored on your computer, smartphone or other device you use for accessing the internet, whenever you visit a website. Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize a user's device.

There are a number of different types of cookies, however, our website uses only the necessary cookies, i.e. cookies which are necessary for the website to function:

First party – Buzzing Wallet Ltd (Buzzing Wallet) uses these cookies so that we recognize you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. We use Cookies to collect information about your use of our website, for example your preferred language, cookie policy acceptance, and if you receive error messages. This information helps us to improve Buzzing Wallet Ltd (Buzzing Wallet) website's performance and develop further our products and services. This information may also be used to help us provide more relevant information to you.

Third party – these cookies help us make our website better for those who visit it regularly. They help us work out what users like and don't like and how we can improve things for you. Buzzing Wallet Ltd (Buzzing Wallet) uses Google Analytics for this purpose. IP anonymization is turned on – only pseudonymous identifiers are being used.

When you visit our website, we ask for your consent to use Cookies.

When we include links to other websites, please bear in mind they will have their own privacy and cookies policies that will govern the use of any information you submit. We recommend you read their policies before accessing their sites.

How to manage cookies

You can delete all cookies that are already on your device by clearing the browsing history of your browser. This will remove all cookies from all websites you have visited. Be aware though that you may also lose some saved information (e.g. saved login details, site preferences).

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, however, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.
